


#### **Overview**


- 227 alumni responded to the Reunion 2023 survey.
- The highest number of survey respondents came from 1976-1980 (54) and 1991-1995 (44).
- 188 respondents highly rated their overall reunion experience as a 4 or 5.
- 172 respondents flew or drove from within the US to get to reunion. 55 respondents traveled from another country.
- 149 respondents attended reunion alone. 78 respondents attended with a spouse and/or family members.
- 79 respondents say their casts meets at other times/years than reunion. Another 71 respondents saying they are thinking about it.
- 44 of 79 respondents said the reason they don't attend reunion is cost, distance, too far to travel, and they only want to see their cast/crew.
- Out of 664 responses, the top 3 event/activities from Reunion were the Era Show (191), Thursday Welcome Dinner (84) and Opening Session (82).
- Out of 172 responses, the most significant event/activity was the Era Show (92), Opening Session (14) and anything with the Belks (11).
- 196 of 227 respondents said having their UWP show and UWP music was an important part of reunion for them, with 139 saying they prefer to participate in the performance.
- 147 of 227 respondents said their cast/crew used the meeting room space.
- Regarding including meals, out of 227 respondents, 135 said they did not want lunch included all days, but 100 said they would like to have a
  package where all meals were included.
- 176 respondents would like a professional group picture taken at reunion, with 165 of them preferring a digital copy of the photo (to 47 who wanted a printed photo to take home).
- 162 of 227 respondents joined the WhatsApp group for reunion. Of that 161, 149 people found the reunion WhatsApp group helpful.
- Of 567 responses, the top alumni communication preferences to hear about opportunities were email (150), from their cast/crew rep (131), from the UWPIAA Facebook group (119), *UpBeat* Newsletter (78).



## On a scale of 1-5, how would you rate this year's UWPIAA Reunion event?




(Reaction at end of survey)

## If you gave the overall reunion experience a rating from 1-5, what would it be?




#### What was the largest motivator in your attendance?




#### If answered "Other":


### How did you travel to attend reunion?



#### Who attended reunion with you?




#### Would you bring your family again?




#### What drove the decision to attend alone or bring family?




## Does your cast/crew meet at other times/years for reunions?



## For those who do not attend UWPIAA Reunions, what reasons do you feel best apply?




## Do you know your Cast/Crew Rep and are they active?



## Did you incorporate reunion in a larger trip?






#### If Other:

- We did a multi-state vacation thru MT, WY, CO, AZ.








#### Please check off your top 3 events/activities from Reunion 2023




# Of the three sessions you checked above, which was THE most significant to you?




# Is having your UWP show and UWP music an important part of reunion to you?






#### Would you like to see more activities and sessions offered at future reunions?




### Several BOG teams will be working on additional options and opportunities in conjunction with Annual Alumni Week. Which of the following appeal to you?




